INTRODUCTION — Trauma to the extremities represents one of the most common injury patterns seen in emergency medical and surgical practice. As extremity injuries are evaluated, each of four functional components (nerves, vessels, bones, and soft tissues) must be considered individually and together. Trial of facet joint injections has resulted in a significant reduction in pain.
