"Davy" Crockett said in his autobiography that John Crockett was born either in Ireland or during the journey from Ireland to America; but later scholars disagreed, saying this had been John's father, also named David. Early life David "Davy" Crockett, the son of John and Rebecca Crockett, was born on August 17, 1786, in East Tennessee.
