A Persian carpet (Persian: ??? ?????? ? farsh, meaning "to spread") or Persian rug (Persian: ???? ?????? q?l?-ye ?ran?), also known as Iranian carpet, is a heavy textile made for a wide variety of utilitarian and symbolic purposes and produced in Iran (historically known as Persia), for home use, local sale, and export. Anatolian rug is a term of convenience, commonly used today to denote rugs and carpets woven in Anatolia (or Asia minor) and its adjacent regions. The brass water basin contains water and a cloth with which one of the nymphs washes Diana's feet after the day's hunt. The basin had Christian overtones of the cleansing of the soul although it was also associated with death. Founded in 1891, with Imperial Habsburg endowments including the art collections of Ferdinand of Tirol, Emperor Rudolf II and Archduke Leopold Wilhelm, the Kunsthistorisches Museum, Vienna (Viennese Museum of Art History) contains one of the finest collections of Old Master paintings.
