Crewe railway station is a railway station in Crewe, Cheshire, England. The station was opened in 1837 and is one of the most historically significant railway stations in the world. Crewe was chosen after Winsford, seven miles to the north, had rejected an earlier proposal, as had local landowners in neighbouring Nantwich, four miles away. Cardiff Central railway station (Welsh: Caerdydd Canolog, formerly 'Cardiff General') is a major station on the South Wales Main Line in Cardiff, the capital of Wales, and one of two hubs of the city's urban rail network.
