Derrick Somerset MACNUTT. Derrick Somerset Macnutt (1902-1971) was a crossword compiler who provided crosswords for The Observer under the pseudonym Ximenes. Adrian BELL. Adrian Bell (1901-1980), a Suffolk farmer, was the setter of the first crossword to appear in The Times. It was published on the 2nd of January 1930, and Bell went on to set about 5,000 puzzles between 1930 and 1978. A cryptic crossword is a crossword puzzle in which each clue is a word puzzle in and of itself. Cryptic crosswords are particularly popular in the United Kingdom, where they originated, Ireland, Israel, the Netherlands, and in several Commonwealth nations, including Australia, Canada, India, Kenya, Malta, New Zealand, and South Africa.
