A carbon tax is a form of pollution tax. Pollution taxes are often grouped with two other economic policy instruments: tradable pollution permits/credits and subsidies. Climate change is a serious global problem that requires both a concerted international response and national efforts to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. Carbon dioxide (CO₂) is the primary greenhouse gas emitted through human activities. In 2017, CO₂ accounted for about 81.6 percent of all U.S. greenhouse gas emissions from human activities.
