Welcome to the Peterborough Diocesan Registry web site. The Anglican Diocese of Peterborough was founded in 1541. It covers an area comprising the County of Northamptonshire, the County of Rutland and a small area of Cambridgeshire around Peterborough, with a population of 847,000. Advowson (or "patronage"; / ʔ d ʔ v a ʔ z ʔ n /) is the right in English law of a patron (avowee) to present to the diocesan bishop (or in some cases the ordinary if not the same person) a nominee for appointment to a vacant ecclesiastical benefice or church living, a process known as presentation (jus praesentandi, Latin: "the right of ...Governance within the Church of England Following the Reformation struggles of the 16th century the Protestant Church of England emerged as the Established church in England, i.e. the official church of the country ("the Church of England as by law established" according to the Canons of 1603).
