

# Download Unemployment Compensation Department V. Hunt

Laws of 1939, and by chapter 253, p. 870, Laws of 1941), issued and caused to be served upon Paul John Hunt, hereinafter referred to as the employer or as appellant, an order and notice of assessment demanding payment of delinquent contributions due the unemployment compensation fund for the period from January 1, 1940, to and including June 30, 1941, in the sum of \$337.93. On September 11th, she filed with the office of unemployment compensation and placement, hereinafter referred to as "the department," her application for the statutory "initial determination" of benefits potentially payable to her under the provisions of the unemployment compensation act.
